Canine Heartworm/Ehrlichiosis/Lyme/Anaplasmosis

Important information about why you should consider having your dog tested every year

Heartworm, ehrlichiosis, Lyme disease and anaplasmosis can be fatal infections. Your dog can become infected with heartworm by a simple mosquito bite, or become infected with ehrlichiosis, Lyme or anaplasmosis if bitten by an infected tick. That's why it's important to test your dog annually for infection.

- Learn if your dog is being exposed to these diseases and if a preventative strategy is needed.
- If your dog is infected, the earlier we test, the earlier we can take action to avoid chronic disease state.

Good News!

We can test for these diseases with one blood sample during your dog's annual screening. For a nominal fee, we will have immediate results. During your visit, we can decide whether your pet may need a preventative or a treatment plan.
